1. Call to Order - 7:00pm
2. Opening Prayer and Treaty 8 Acknowledgement was read by Stephane Gaudreau
3. Approval of October Minutes - Lynn Haunholter and Dani Bedford

6. Glenmary Bus Seatbelts update - Gayle Walton
 - a. Look at encouraging students to use seatbelts. Policy states there needs to be a secondary supervisor for any trip outside of Peace River to verify that students are using seat belts. It is being enforced.
 - b. Was asked if it is possible to do a campaign at school around seatbelt safety as right now there is a campaign for Buckle up for Broncos. Perhaps the school could coincide with this one.
 - c. Reminder to coaches to enforce seat belt usage regularly.

 - a. There are 2 spots that have signage in student parking lot and one in staff parking.
8. Europe Trip - Brendon Nichols
 - a. First parent interest meeting was on Monday November 19. Close to 70 students interested. Voting for trip location is Friday. Trip is for the Spring of 2021. Once voting is done, approval process will begin. Monique Randall will bring information about the trip to Holy Family School. Explorica is the name of the tour group. Fundraising is being organized.

 - a. HFCRD Budget Process - Highlights were given out. Discussed what an 18-1 ratio means.
 - b. Graduation Guidelines - as per Administrative Procedure 367, the graduation guidelines were presented for review. No requests for changes were made.
 - c. S-Endorsement Training - Lauri Goudreault read a letter from Jarrett Futch, the director of business from HFCRD. By March 1, 2019, all drivers of commercial vehicles including our minibuses, will need to have S-Endorsement training completed.
