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## **DNL Form** *Demonstrating New Learning Form*

Everyone deserves a second chance to bring up their mark. If a student is not satisfied with their current achievement on a test or assignment they can apply to their teacher to demonstrate their new learning. This new learning will only apply to summative assessments and will not be the same as the initial assessment but will still cover the same outcomes.

The process for this application is simple. Please fill out this form and bring any required evidence to your teacher in a timely manner.

After the application is complete the teacher and applicant will meet to discuss the application. Not all applications will be successful. An application may be denied in the following situations:

1. Evidence that the student is refusing to work or finish any type of formative or summative assessment that leads to the new learning.
2. Professional judgment
3. Student is late or does not show up to the teacher meeting.
4. Failure to complete the application form.

If there are any questions on the rejection of the application all teachers are willing to discuss the situation with students and parents.
